### TENTATIVE REGULAR AGENDA

“Tentative” signifies that there may be further changes to the agenda due to actions taken by the filing agency prior to the JCARR meeting. A “Final” agenda will be issued the day of the JCARR meeting. New, amended, revised, and rescinded rules appear on the Regular agenda. Rules under five-year review for which there are no changes appear on the No-Change agenda.



### Consent

This signifies which section of the agenda the rule is on. See below for descriptions of parts of the agenda.

The date the rule was filed with JCARR, LSC, and the Secretary of State.

If this field appears, it indicates that the rule filing agency revised or refiled the rule after the original filing date.

Item Number

Department, agency, board, or commission filing/proposing rule.

Division name appears if applicable.

Procedures.

This field indicates what type of rule the agency is filing. It could be a newly proposed rule, an amendment to an existing rule, or a rescission.

This field indicates what action the agency is taking on the rule: Original Filing; Revised Filing; Refiled Filing; To be Refiled (TBR); or Withdrawn Filing.

If “Yes” appears in this field, the rule has an “adverse impact” on business as defined in O.R.C. 107.52 and thus was submitted to the Common Sense Initiative Office (CSIO) for evaluation prior to its filing with JCARR.

If “Yes” appears in this field, the rule has been reviewed by the filing agency using the criteria outlined in O.R.C. 106.03 & 106.031 and the entire rule is subject to review. If “No” appears in this field, either the rule is new or only the changes the agency is making to the rule are subject to review. A rule exempt from FYR will show “Exempt” in this field.

The rule’s current title. If the agency proposes changes to the rule title, they will not be reflected until the rule is final filed.

This is the date the agency’s public hearing is to be conducted. If the rule is promulgated pursuant to O.R.C. 111.15, no public hearing is required, and the hearing date will be blank.

#### Four Sections of the Agenda

**Consent** – JCARR is not aware of opposition testimony requesting motions to invalidate the proposed rule.

**To Be Refiled** – The filing agency has submitted notice to JCARR of its intention to refile the rule at a later date.

**Withdrawn** – The filing agency has withdrawn the filing. This action removes the filing from JCARR review.

**Review** – There has been indication at or prior to the JCARR meeting that individual(s) plan to testify before JCARR on the rule.
